

SCHOOL INFORMATION



Gordon Elementary School opened at Linden Oaks in January 2009, and funding for a second elementary school and a middle school has been approved. Until the additional schools are opened, new Linden Oaks residents in grades pre-K through 5 will be assigned to a Main Post school. Fort Bragg bus transportation will be available.

Students in grades 6th – 8th will attend schools on Main Post. Bus transportation will be available.

Ninth grade students may attend Allbritton Junior High School or Overhills High School in Spring Lake. Albritton students will be provided bus transportation by Fort Bragg Schools. Overhills students will be provided bus transportation by Harnett County Schools.

Students in grades 10th-12th will attend Overhills High School in Spring Lake. Bus transportation will be provided by Harnett County Schools.

To receive a school assignment for Main Post, families should contact the Fort Bragg Assistant Superintendent's Office at (910-) 907-0200 ext. 3002 after accepting Linden Oaks housing. The office is located by Irwin Intermediate School Fort Bragg's Knox Street. To register at Overhills High School, call (910) 498-6277.

WAIT LISTS & RELOCATIONS

What wait lists are open for Linden Oaks homes?

- Junior Enlisted (E1-E5) Four-Bedroom Homes
- Senior NCO (E6-E9) Four-Bedroom Homes
- Company Grade Officer (WO1-O3) Four-Bedroom Homes
- Field Grade Officer (WO4-O5) Four-Bedroom Homes

Who qualifies for the above waitlists?

Incoming Families and current residents that meet rank and 4-bedroom eligibility requirements.

How do I check my wait list position?

Periodically, construction and development plans for Main Post may require that current, Main Post residents be relocated to Linden Oaks or recently constructed homes in other neighborhoods. Accordingly, these families will receive new home priority from time to time. Therefore, we ask that Linden Oaks housing applicants directly contact the Linden Oaks Neighborhood Center for their wait list position and/or current wait times. Please disregard the wait list positioning provided on the Army OneStop website.

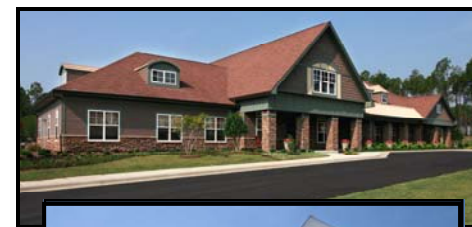
How do I apply, or who should I contact for more info?
